NUT-FREE SPACE

Mayflower has made a commitment to providing a safe building for people with severe nut allergies. Did you know it's not enough for a person with a nut allergy to avoid eating nuts? Sometimes, peanut protein residue remains in the air or on the surfaces where food has been served. This can cause a life-threatening reaction if an allergic person inhales any airborne residue or touches a surface where nuts have been. Here are some ways you can help avoid this:

- Do not bring food with nut ingredients (like peanut butter or pecan muffins) to church, even just for your own lunch.
- Be aware that people with allergies will select only foods that they can be sure have not contacted nuts (or other allergens) such as store-brought bread. Don't take it personally if they avoid certain dishes or bring their own.
- Whatever you were serving, wipe down the tables and take rinsed dishes to the kitchen or bus tub after your meal or event.

ZERO WASTE SPACE

If food will be served, all groups are asked to help us reach our goal of zero-waste—that is: a minimum of plastic and garbage. Items like Capri-Sun, single-use water bottles, and plastic utensils are discouraged. Food waste, paper, and even pizza boxes can go in the green organic compost bins!

Mark on the reservation form whether you will use our reusable plates or compostables. The church can provide them, or you can bring your own – but all disposable products must be BPI-certified. Unfortunately, the disposable paper plates with glossy finishes cannot go into the compost. If you have questions, just ask us! Together we can make a difference.

For groups larger than 10 people using real dishes, we ask that you run them through the dishwasher. Arrange with admin@mayflowermpls.org in advance to learn how to operate it.

NOTES ON AUDIO AND VISUAL EQUIPMENT

We are evaluating needs for audio and visual equipment, and hope to improve access to these items for Mayflower groups. Currently, we offer:

-A projector, and a selection of cords for connecting it to your laptop.

-A portable screen that can be set up in most rooms.

-Microphone on a stand with built in speakers (in dining room only). We regret that our portable mic/speaker are not working, so the Dining Room is currently the best space for events requiring a mic.

If you require the projector, please designate someone in your group to set it up, operate it, and put it away. You are welcome to come in advance to do a trial run. Indicate to the office to make arrangements for learning how to use the projector and return it to the cabinet after your event.
